3 Scholarships for Writing an Interdisciplinary PhD Thesis in British Studies

Responsibilities: Preparing a PhD on an interdisciplinary British Studies subject. A range of different courses on skill development and on interdisciplinary research methods will be available to scholarship winners. Participation in the Centre's study days (colloquia), interdisciplinary reading group, master classes organised for PhD students will be required.

Requirements: An excellent degree in a subject which is related to British Studies (history, art history, law, political science, sociology, economics, ethnology and/or anthropology, literature and culture) and that qualifies for a PhD; an original interdisciplinary research proposal for a PhD thesis with a focus on the UK; preferably from a comparative or cultural exchange-studies perspective; excellent knowledge of spoken and written English, or native-speaker German with advanced English skills. Acceptance of the Berlin Graduate School of British Studies' doctoral regulations and acceptance of a supervision agreement.

Scholarship: The *Richtlinie für Vergabe von Stipendien durch strukturierte Promotionsprogramme, die im Rahmen der 3. Förderlinie der Exzellenzinitiative von Bund und Ländern unterstützt werden* is applicable; the amount is 1468 Euros per month.

There is no enrolment fee.
