

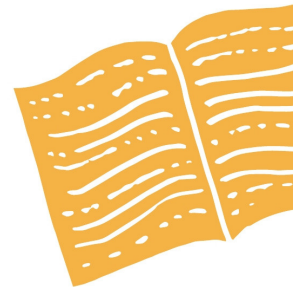
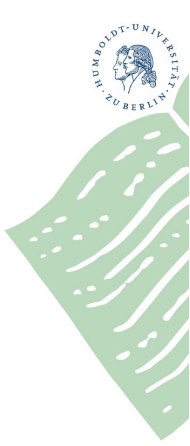
ALL THE WORLD'S A PAGE: How to Travel the World With Literature
