Prof Brigid Laffan

**Emeritus Professor of European Politics,
European University Institute, Florence**

Brigid Laffan is Emeritus Professor at the European University Institute. Prof. Laffan was Director and Professor at the Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies and Director of the Global Governance Programme and the European Governance and Politics Programme at the European University Institute, Florence until her retirement in 2021. Previously, Prof. Laffan was Professor of European Politics at the School of Politics and International Relations (SPIRe) University College Dublin, where she was Vice-President of UCD and Principal of the College of Human Sciences from 2004 to 2011. Prof. Laffan was also the founding director of the Dublin European Institute UCD from 1999. In March 2004 she was elected as a member of the Royal Irish Academy.

Stefan Telle is Assistant Professor for European Governance and Politics at the University of Twente (2023-).
