Applications for the Course Starting October 2025

Application requirements

Applicants need to have a **university degree** at the time of formal enrolment (October 2025). This first degree can be in any subject. With usually over 100 applications for 30 places, admission is highly competitive. The diversity in standards of university teaching and grading throughout the world makes it impossible to impose any formal requirements on the minimum grade to be obtained. As a rule of thumb, though, successful applicants with a Bachelor (e.g. BA, LLB, BSc) or similar degree tend to have graduated within the top 10-15%, successful applicants with a Master (e.g., MA, LLM, MSc) or similar degree within the top 15-20% of their class. We will, however, look at the individual circumstances of each case.

Applicants need to speak **very good English**. The application must contain proof of your proficiency equivalent to C1 level in the form of an ETS TOEFL certificate (minimum score of 600 for the paper-based test, 250 for the computer-based test, or 100 for the internet-based test), or a Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (any grade), or a Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (grade A or B), or an IELTS test (level 7.0). Neither a degree in English language, nor English language teaching experience will be considered as adequate proof. Only native speakers are exempt from this requirement. Applicants that can show an equivalent to C2 will have an advantage.

Furthermore, a working knowledge of **German** is highly advisable.

Application procedure

The deadline for applications is 30th April (for admission in October). Places are allocated and all applicants notified around mid-July.

Grants

Applicants who are in need of a scholarship are strongly advised to apply to institutions such as the German Academic Exchange Service (http://www.daad.de) and to search for other opportunities via directories such as http://www.stiftungen.com. Please note that the German Academic Exchange Service usually operates with an earlier deadline than the course itself, November of the preceding year for enrolment in October.

Your application **must also include** the following documents in the order in which they are listed below.

IMPORTANT:

Do not submit irreplaceable original documents, but send us certified copies. Please note: a simple copy of a certified copy is not itself a certified copy! The certified copy has to include an <u>original official stamp</u> and <u>signature</u> (public authority or notary) on it.

Please tick the boxes in order to indicate that the papers are attached.

□ a certified copy of your secondary school leaving certificate which qualifies for university
studies (e.g. A-Levels certificate, Abiturzeugnis, Baccalaureat, High School Diploma) including a breakdown of subjects and grades – together with a certified English translation, unless the original is in English or German;
$\hfill \square$ a certified copy of your university degree certificate, $\underline{\text{including your final overall grade}}$ as well
as a breakdown of subjects and grades – together with a certified English translation, unless the original is in English or German. If you have yet to receive this, we will require written confirmation of your expected final grade from your university.* If neither the provision of a final, overall grade nor the prediction of such a grade is possible, we need written confirmation from your university of this fact;
□ an APS <u>original</u> , if you earned your university degree from a university in China, Mongolia or Vietnam.
□ a certified copy of grade transcripts of your university studies – together with a certified English translation, unless the original is in English or German (as above);
□ proof of your proficiency in the English language through ETS TOEFL, IELTS, CPE or CAE scores in original or in certified copy (in the case of IELTS and TOEFL a simple copy will suffice). This does not apply to native speakers.
□ a copy of your passport – the page with your photo and personal details will suffice.

*Important: If you are presently in your final year at university and have not yet received your degree document you can nevertheless apply, provided you will have completed your present course before October. Please attach a confirmation of your university and a list of the subjects you have studied so far, including exam results, along with your predicted final grade.
